ABSTRACT

The panel on CSO engagement with ASEAN and its member states hope to bring the voices and perspectives on the status of CSO engagement at different levels and given varying degrees of democratic spaces available. The workshop will feature three key concerns focusing on the challenges on the existing legal framework relative to CSO engagement at member state level and at the regional level through the critical assessment of the CPRs guideline for CSO engagement, secondly, the workshop will feature concrete experiences in maximizing the claimed and invited spaces for constructive engagement in three countries (Cambodia, Philippines and Indonesia). The concern on development effectiveness shall bring additional perspective in the conversation on avenues for CSO engagement. Key recommendation out of the conversation and exchanges shall be drafted geared towards ensuring the meaningful engagement of CSOs in making people-centered ASEAN.
