**CamboDHRRA-HIGHLIGHTS OF OPERATIONS/ PERFORMANCE

MOST SIGNIFICANT ACHIEVEMENT** in terms of:

I. Empowering Rural Peoples' Organizations (RPOs) in delivering effective services to their members, influencing policymakers, and contributing to rural transformation.

CamboDHRRA organized and facilitated 15 training and meetings with 151 participants (59 females) from Government, NGO/iNGo, Private sectors, AC, Academia, Farmer organization. The most significant achievement as below:

- One AgriCoop shop established and supported, 15 ACs across 8 provinces are members.
- Business partnership developed between Khmer Drone Technology (KDT), FWN and FCFD. The facilitation of contract farming among members of CamboDHRRA such as FNN, DPA and CACC/AMRU RICE on organic rice, FNN and KOC on organic vegetable.
- 14 ACs improved business operation management (Business plan, Marketing strategy and financial management) to meet Chamroeun Microfinance PLC (CMP)'s requirement.
- List of ACs under CamboDHRRA intervention are consolidated.
- FO monitoring tool have applied by CamboDHRRA's member (FNN and DCA partners)
- 8 experts strengthened capacity and provided services to CamboDHRRA.

In addition, CamboDHRRA also organized and facilitated 7 of workshops, dialogues, and forums with 260 participants (112 females) from Government, NGO/iNGo, Private sectors, AC, Academia, Farmer

organizations. Four research and scoping study conducted and one strategy paper on empowering women and youth in responsible agriculture investment developed. CamboDHRRA is leading organization in promoting ASEAN RAI in Cambodia.

II. Leading priority Rural Development and Poverty Eradication (RDPE) agenda at the national, regional & global spheres

CamboDHRRA organized and facilitated 42 trainings/workshops and meetings with 495 participants (181 females) from Government, NGO/iNGO, Private sectors, AC, Academia and Farmer Organizations. The most significant achievement as below:

- Digital Village Ecosystem Assessment (DVEA) conducted and developed initiatives for mobilizing resources.
- 15 members of CamboDHRRA (NGOs, FOs and companies) and 7 NGO partners improved their capacity and knowledge on ASEAN RAI, AC development, Digital agriculture and Collective form economic etc.

III. Innovating in offering value and data-driven programs & services to RDPE stakeholders towards sustainability.

In 2022, CamboDHRRA organized and facilitated 20 trainings/workshops and meetings with 27 participants (8 females) from Government, NGO/iNGO, Private sectors, AC, Academia and Farmer organizations. The most significant achievement as below:

- CamboDHRRA created a room for discussion/reflection/learning between companies, farmer organizations (FO) and CSOs in value chains and AC related.
- Be a facilitator for business engagement between companies and FOs.
- Connecting ACs to access loan from MFI.
