### Taiwan DHRRA- HIGHLIGHTS OF OPERATIONS/ PERFORMANCE (2021-2022)



#### From 2021-2022, what was your organization's **MOST SIGNIFICANT ACHIEVEMENT\*\*** in terms of:

#### I. Empowering Rural Peoples' Organizations (RPOs) in delivering effective services to their members, influencing policymakers, and contributing to rural transformation.

The partner RPOs are mainly farmers organizations, but we also support other organizations that provide services directly or indirectly link policy formation and contributing to rural transformation. The activities include regular support for AFA members (TWADA and TDFA) in Taiwan mainly for AFA related events (consultation, translation, for the preparatory meeting such as working group meeting, ExeCom Meetings, arranging membership payment issues, accompanying women farmers joining virtual meetings. We also deliver direct services to farmers and stakeholders through other partners such as associations, foundations, and international centers mainly through served as speakers in the training programs, jointly supervising student-interns conducting their semester-long training in farming related agribusiness as well as farmers organizations. The followings are some examples of services:

For instance in January of 2021, we identified suitable woman farmers from TWADA and TDFA for joining AFA Women Farmers Committee meeting held virtually on January 22. In August 2021, a consultation meeting to a young farmers group (a federated horticultural coop formed by young farmers) in Malaysia that was identified by the agricultural extension channel and alumni association of NPUST, which expressed their interest about joining AFA. The consultation meeting was organized by the Rural Development Foundation of Taiwan (Aug 17).

In April 2022, I was invited by district (township level) farmers association for an annual event of pineapple growers competition for their best practice in the field as well as the product delivery. The products from more than 40 farmers in the area were blind-evaluated on the venue for sensory, measured

This paper received the "Excellent Award" for paper competition of the conference)" Dr. Shqdiqur finished his doctoral program the following year and is now working at the UB.

Dr. Wen-Chi Huang supervised an international student (from Malaysia) in January 2021 to conduct internship at the Agricultural Policy Center of the Agricultural Research Institute in Taiwan focusing on the Green Deal of EU. She supervised an international student (from The Gambia) in August-Sept 2022 to conduct internship at the Ministry of Agriculture in The Gambia through the two former advisees who work in the Ministry.
